# Lisson Grove Local Safety Scheme

#### Westminster City Council has improved Pedestrian and cyclist facilities

## Construction dates: July 2009 – April 2010

- These works improved the safety for all road users in Lisson Grove by upgrading the pedestrian crossings, providing facilities for cyclists and installing skid resistant surfacing.
- Lisson Grove carriageway was resurfaced between Lodge Road and Broadley Street in August 2009.
- The traffic signals at Church Street junction were modified.
- New traffic signals were installed at the junction with Frampton Street to provide improved crossing facilities for pedestrians and cyclists.
- The junction with Ashmill Street was improved by reducing the width of Lisson Grove and shortening the length of the Zebra crossing.
- The majority of the works were completed during the School Holidays.
