

# The Colonnades Public Realm Improvements

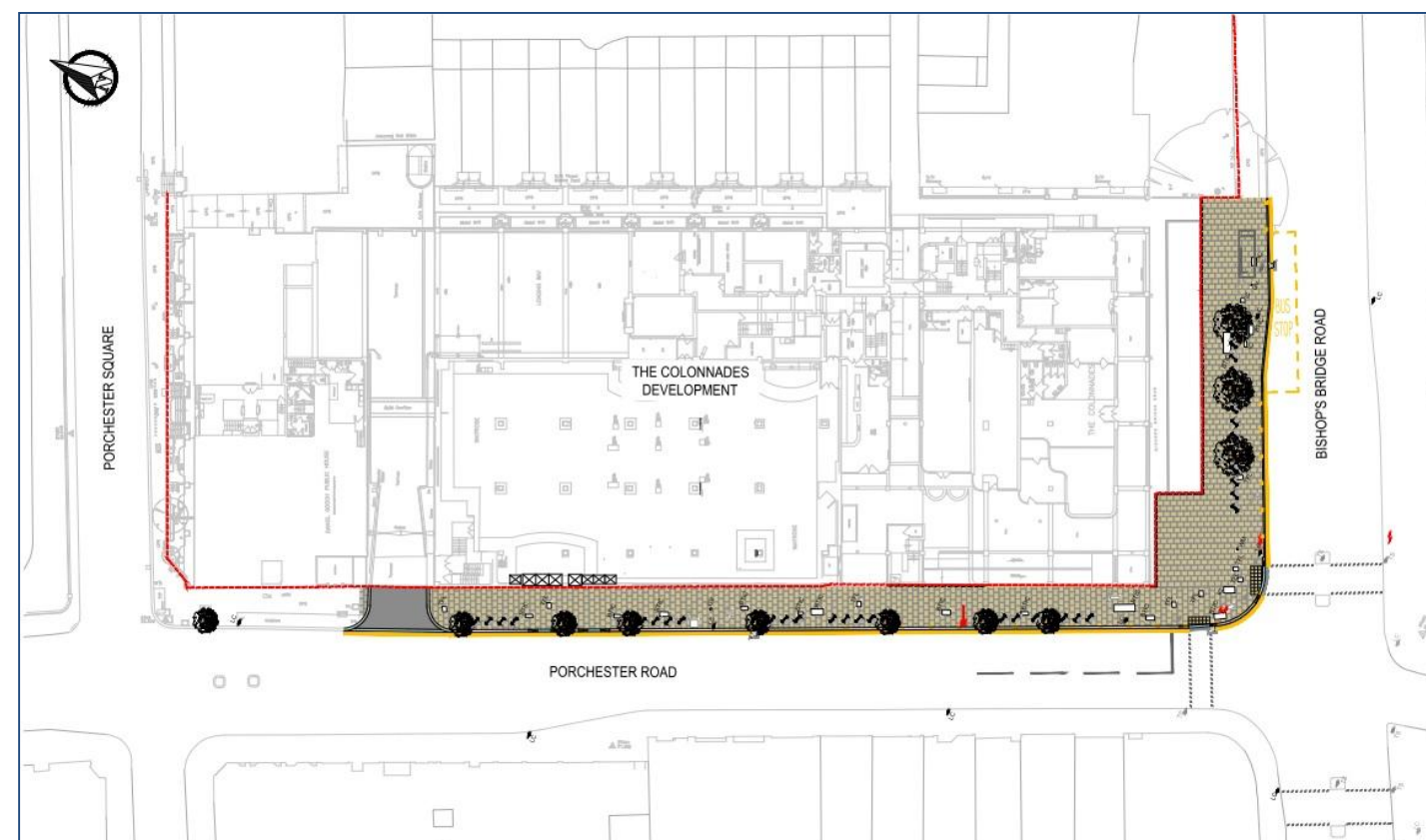
**Westminster City Council**

**Programme work dates: 16 May 2016 – 22 July 2016**

**These Improvements include:**

- Repaving footways with new yorkstone paving and granite kerbs
- Introduction of seven new street trees on Porchester Road
- Replacement of the three existing street trees on Bishop's Bridge Road
- Installation of 21 cycle stands on Porchester Road and 10 cycle stands on Bishops Bridge Road
- New dropped kerbs to improve accessibility for pedestrians at the signalised pedestrian facilities at the junction of Porchester Road and Bishop's Bridge Road
- Decluttering the streetscape by removing redundant street furniture
