Westminster City Council is providing streetscape improvements on Torquay Street

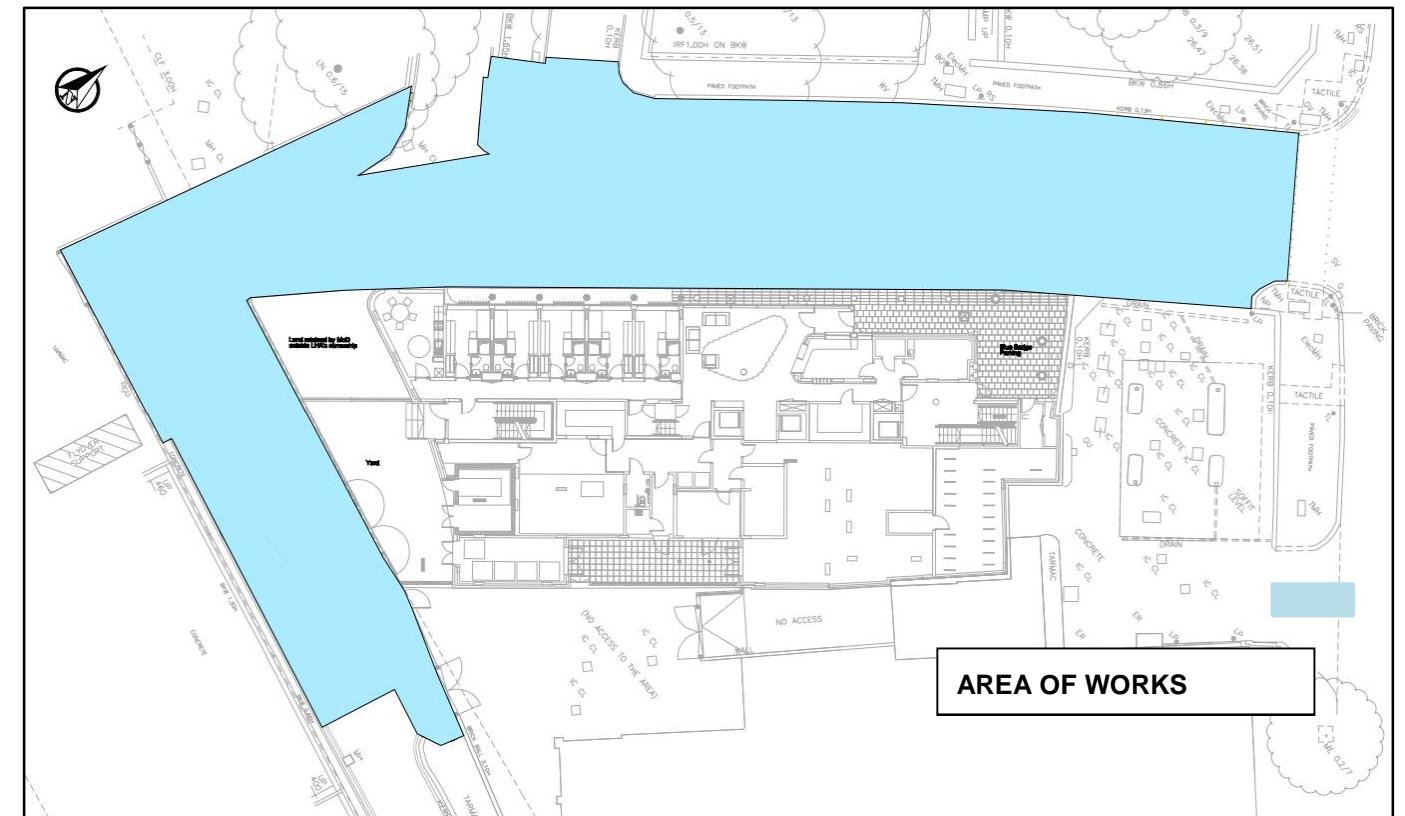
Cleaner, safer and brighter environment for all users

Programme dates: October 2014 – February 2015

As part of the Streetscape Improvements being undertaken by Westminster City Council, the public highway along Torquay Street is to be upgraded.

The works in Torquay Street include:

- Repaving the south eastern footway and northern footway (beneath the Westway Flyover) of Torquay Street using Artificial Stone Paving (ASP) and mastic asphalt;
- New granite kerbs;
- New asphalt surfacing;
- A new Pay by Phone bay drop off area in front of the development;
- Introducing “At Any Time” waiting and loading restrictions;
- Installing bicycle stands.
